Non-Degree Credit

CSU GE

(California State Universities General Education)

Courses with this designation satisfy general education breadth requirements for California State Universities (CSU campuses).

IGETC

(UC Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum)

Courses with this designation satisfy lower division general education requirements at any CSU or UC campus.

CSU/UC

Courses with this designation are transferable to the campus of the University of California **AND** the California State University system.

- Courses **NOT** marked "UC" are **NOT transferable** to the University of California campuses.
- Students should confer with a counselor for information regarding transferability of courses marked **UC Limitation**.

C-ID

(Course Identification Number)

Courses with this designation will articulate with any other California Community Colleges (CCC) courses with the same designation for course content credit. C-ID

SOC JUST

(Social Justice, Equity and Sustainability)

Courses with this designation satisfy the Cypress College Social Justice, Equity and Sustainability requirement.

RDG

(Reading)

Courses with this designation satisfy the Cypress College Reading Proficiency Graduation requirement.
